MISSION

The Children's Coalition for Northeast Louisiana is dedicated to creating communities where children and families thrive. We address the needs of children and youth ages 0-18 in four main areas: **Early Childhood, Parenting, Healthy Living, and Youth Development.**

HOW WE SERVE

Headquartered in Downtown Monroe, we serve the northeast region of Louisiana. With over 20 programs, we focus on providing services that educate, advocate, and care for the children and the adults who care for them. Our programs include Early Head Start, which provides quality child care for children from birth through age three. Child Care Connections help parents find quality child care, as well as provides pro-active based coaching and training to child care providers throughout the year. Al's Pals teaches preschool children the social-emotional and resiliency skills to make healthy choices. Signs of Suicide is vital now more than ever to help middle school students recognize signs of depression and suicide in not only themselves but others around them. Students, teachers, school nurses, and community members are also trained to recognize signs and concerns in students and youth. Our Family Resource Centers provide families in the Department of Children and Family Services and foster care system with family skill building and visit coaching to help reunite families. Union Parish Alliance for Community Transformation selects ambassadors to draw awareness and a plan to address underage drinking and prescription drug abuse in Union Parish.

In addition to cleaning our Early Start playgrounds, volunteers can also enjoy helping with the activities in the Origin Bank Family Garden intended to promote positive family interactions, garden-based learning, healthy living, art and movement. SCHOOL READINESS GOALS

Approaches To Learning

Goal 1: Children will demonstrate attentiveness, motivation, and creativity while exploring their surroundings.

Goal 2: Children will demonstrate persistence and reasoning to reach a specific goal.

Social And Emotional Development

Goal 1: Children will develop and engage in positive relationships and interactions with peers/adults.

Goal 2: Children will learn and establish ways to recognize and positively manage their emotions and behaviors.

Language And Communication

Goal 1: Children will engage and increasingly understand physical and verbal communication from others.

Goal 2: Children will progress in their ability to physically and verbally communicate to others.

Goal 3: Children will show interest and knowledge of the sounds and patterns of the spoken and written language.

Cognition

Goal 1: Children will gain understanding about mathematical approaches as they explore the environment.

Goal 2: Children will gain understanding of the objects and people in their environment, how they work, how change happens, and being able to make connections between new and old information through all senses.

Perceptual, Motor, And Physical Development

Goal 1: Children will develop skills for large muscles of arms and legs through balance, movement, and manipulation of objects.

Goal 2: Children will develop controlled skills for small muscles of fingers and hands through exploring and using objects in the environment.

SCHOOL READINESS TAX CREDITS

WHAT ARE THEY?

- Dollar-for-Dollar refundable tax credit on Louisiana state taxes
- Up to \$5,000 per Louisiana Tax ID, with no minimum amount
- Laws passed in 2007 and effective in 2008 (La. Rev. Stat.47:6107)
- Designed to support quality child care and education
- Re-directing tax dollars locally - as an investment in our children
- Only Louisiana Child Care Resource and Referral Agencies can receive the money
- The Children's Coalition for Northeast Louisiana is the Child Care Resource and Referral Agency for our region

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All Louisiana owned businesses are eligible. A business is defined as any for-profit or not-for-profit entity and includes sole proprietors (so long as the individual is not acting in his/her personal capacity), partnerships, limited liability corporations and corporations.

WHY SHOULD YOU CONTRIBUTE?

Companies can donate up to \$5,000 and get it back as a credit against that company's state income taxes or as a direct rebate from the state treasury. Companies with multiple tax ID numbers can donate up to \$5,000 for each corporation.*

*If your business' state return flows through your personal state return, \$5,000 is the maximum allowed per personal state return.

MENTAL HEALTH CONSULTATION

Tulane Institute of Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health

Mental Health Consultants provide education, training and resources on developmentally appropriate behavior for children in the classroom. Children are observed and screened to ensure centers are equipped with the best tools and techniques for healthy educational environments. Consultants serve centers across 12 parishes.

In the classroom, Mental Health Consultants:

- Make referrals to parents based on a child's individual needs
- Provide milestone resources to parents for understanding child development
- Follow up with children, parents, and teachers for recommendations made
- Recommend techniques for reducing stress and resolving conflict
- Model how to address unacceptable behavior in a constructive way
- Demonstrate how to redirect and move forward after classroom altercations

To assist educators, Mental Health Consultants:

- Observe classroom dynamics and offer fresh perspective on improvements
- Model how to approach families about delays and behavioral concerns
- Interact with parents to address progression and delay questions
- Offer resources for foster families regarding children dealing with trauma

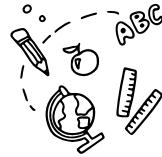
